GAMEPLAY 5





2, 3 or 4 players

Play with just the normal Rock, Paper and Scissor cards (Ace, 2-10, Queen, Jack and King).

Aim

Bluff or tell the truth... Just get rid of your cards!

How to Play

- You're reading this so you're in charge...
- Shuffle the cards... Then deal the cards out among the players.
- Make sure no one else sees the faces of your cards. The player on your left now puts any Aces in their hand face down in a Discard Pile... And tells everyone what they're playing: "One Ace" or "Two Aces", for example.
- If they have NO Aces, they can say "Pass!". BUT they can also BLUFF...

In other words, if that person doesn't have any Aces, or has one but wants to PRETEND they have MORE, they can. They simply play non-Ace cards and SAY, "One Ace" or "Two Aces", etc. Play then moves clockwise...

 The next player can now claim they also have Aces, or cards with one value above or below an Ace. In other words, they can say they have two Aces, Twos or Kings. If play goes all the way from Aces to Kings, you may start with Aces again. The winner is the first to get rid of ALL their cards.

HOWEVER... If any of you thinks a player is bluffing, you can challenge them. Just call out, "No way!". The challenged player must show everyone whether or not it's a bluff...

• Anyone who IS caught bluffing must pick up the Discard Pile and add it to their cards. If they WEREN'T bluffing, though, then the challenger picks up the pile.

First to get rid of ALL their cards WINS.

PLAY WITH JUST THESE CARDS...

Queen, King.



All **ROCK** cards: Ace, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, Jack, Queen, King.



All **PAPER** cards: Ace, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, Jack,



All **SCISSORS** cards: Ace, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, Jack,

Ace, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, Jack, Queen, King.
